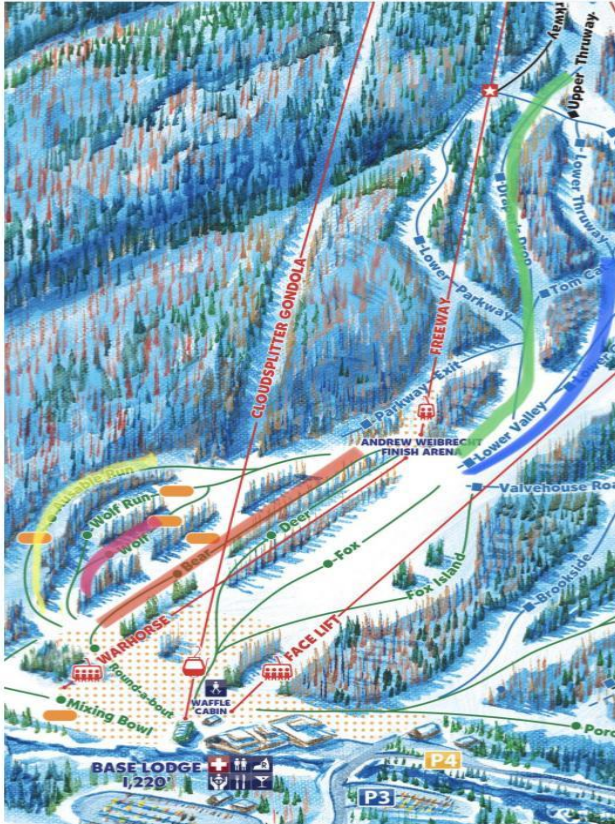

# Captains Meeting

**Teams are required to have a representative present at every captains meeting**

- . In depth information about the next days event(s)**
- . Schedule changes/ weather information.**
- . Seeding information**



# Skier/Boarder Cross

- . Ausable Run accessed by Warhorse chairlift
- . Start with course inspection for the snowboarders followed by skiers
- . Brief riders meeting, start time trials for snowboarders
- . After the snowboarders finish brief riders meeting for skiers then begin time trials
- . Move into brackets for skiers and boarders
- . 32 people from each move into brackets from time trials.
- . Alternate skier/boarder brackets up to finals.
- . Brief description of rules related to cross.



# Rail Jam

- . Lower Wolf Run accessible from Warhorse chair lift
- . Judging format overall impression (more detailed description given in riders meeting)
- . Jam format (1 controlled drop followed by open jam)
- . Allotted time slot per each heat (ex. 25 minute heat(s) for men skiers)
- . Inverted aerials are permitted



# Slopestyle

- Bear slope accessible from Warhorse chair lift.
- Judging format will be best of 2 runs for both qualifying and finals
- Number of athletes move on from qualifying to finals to be determined
- More detailed info given in riders meeting
- Inverted aerials are permitted



# Snowboard Alpine Slalom / Giant Slalom

- **Snowboard Slalom / GS (Lower Thruway to Lower Valley White face mountain)**
- **Snowboard Slalom, Full reset between runs with time to inspect for second run**
- **Snowboard GS, Full reset between runs with time to inspect for the second run**
