



CHANGE LOG – USCSA RULES 2019-2020

2019.v.1.1 – Changes Approved by the USCSA Rules Committee and Board of Directors in the Rule Making period from June 11, 2018 through July 31, 2019.

1. New Conference Coordinators

New conference coordinators were approved in the Eastern Conference, Northern California Conference, and the Southwest Conference.

2. Grammatical Language Clean-Up

Pursuant to Bylaw 10.13.2, minor changes to the grammar, spelling, and punctuation have been made throughout the Competition and Rules Manual with no resulting effect on the modified rules.

3. Review of 4-Way Completed as indicated in 8.2.1.5.6

The 4-Way competition is to continue unchanged in the 2019-2020 Season after review in the 2019 rule making period.

4. Official Interpretation modified for Alpine Rule 2.1.2.3.1

The Official Interpretation (O.I.) was modified for Alpine Rule 2.1.2.3.1. to clarify and simplify the rule application.

5. Rule 7.5.3.3. updated to clarify requirement for team inclusion in Team Combined Awards

Rule 7.5.3.3. was updated, removing the term “individual” from the rule for clarity on what was meant by use of the term “individual”.

6. Rules 7.4.5.2.1 and 7.4.5.2.2. were added to the Snowboard Section, defining a 50% rule for inclusion in the Snowboard Alpine and Snowboard Freestyle Championship Results.

After 2018 changes created distinct Snowboard Alpine and Snowboard Freestyle Championships, sections 7.4.5.2.1 and 7.4.5.2.2 were added to institute 50% participation rule requirements for inclusion in the overall results of each distinct Championship for the 2019-2020 season.

7. Team and Individual Registration and Fee structures were updated in portions of Section 2.1.1.

Changes in price and clarity in application of pricing structure were implemented in section 2.1.1. and subsequent sections were added and renumbered in the CAR Manual. Pricing was omitted from the rule book and added to the USCSA website, available at www.USCSA.com.

8. Alpine Membership Berths rule, 8.2.3.1. was updated to reflect changes made in Section 2.1.1.2

Team size was cleaned up in Rules 2.1.1.2 and therefore the requirement for 3 or more members per team for inclusion in Alpine Berth determination system is maintained as previously intended and located in the appropriate session.

9. Qualifications for the Holger Peterson Award were updated to match the Bylaw restructuring completed in 2018.

Rule 7.8.1.1.1. was updated to reflect the current Bylaws, increasing the number of eligible recipients back to the original number intended prior to the reduction of the size of the board of Directors in 2018.

10. Nordic rule 4.2.3.1 was eliminated.

11. Separation of Competition and Rules Manual (CAR) from Bylaws and Articles of Incorporation

The Board of Directors opted to separate the publications of the Sport Competition and Rules Manual from the USCSA Organizational Bylaws and Articles of Incorporation. Both will remain available as separate documents at www.USCSA.com.
