



CHANGE LOG – USCSA RULES 2018-2019

2018.v.1.1 – Changes Approved by the Board on 6/9/2018.

1. New Conference Coordinators

New conference coordinators were approved in the Eastern Conference, Northern California and the Southwest Conference.

2. Nordic Sprint Event

No changes to the rule took place, other than to reference that the Nordic Sprint Race would run in accordance with FIS ICR 36 in Rule 4.2.3.

3. Push-Off Posts for Start Areas

Rule 5.2.2 was changed to clarify which events require push-off posts.

Rule 6.2.2 was changed to clarify which events require push-off posts.

4. Execution of Snowboard & Skier Cross

Snowboard 5.9.3.1 clarifies how the snowboard cross is executed in the event that time trials are not conducted.

Freeski 6.9.3.1 clarifies how the Skier Cross is executed in the event that time trials are not conducted.

5. Freeski Requirements for Start

Rule 6.2.7.1 stating that a competitor must start with both feet attached to the board has been removed, because it references snowboarding equipment instead of skiing equipment.

6. Snowboard Chief Gate Judge and Head Judge Clarification

Rule 5.16.8 was changed to include all Snowboard Alpine events, not just Giant Slalom.

Rule 5.16.9 was changed to include all Snowboard Freestyle events, not just snowboard cross.

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7. Competition Committee Roles

Rule 6.14.1 was updated to define the events for which a Chief Gate Judge or a Head Judge would be required.

8. Responsibilities of the TD

Rule 6.15.7.1 was updated to properly reference Freeski instead of Snowboard for the Freeski T.D.

9. Four-Event Scoring

Rule 7.1.1 has been updated to remove ambiguity around which Nordic events are used in the calculation of the 4-Way results. Team scoring for the President's Award for 4-way performance is accomplished by using the point by place scoring system for Alpine Slalom, Alpine Giant Slalom, individual start Nordic event, and the Nordic Team Sprint.

10. Eligibility for Post-Season Competition

Rule 8.1.3.2.1 was added to provide additional requirements for conferences to post results on the USCSA website. In order to be eligible for post-season competition, conferences must submit results to the USCSA website.

11. Removal of National Championship Committee

Per the adoption of the revised operating bylaws of the USCSA, the National Championship Committee has been removed.

12. Removal of Article 9 of the Articles of Incorporation

The Board of Directors has voted with the requisite number of votes to remove Article IX, referencing old contact information for the corporation.

13. Bylaws of the USCSA Revised Section 10

Per the Board of Directors meeting on June 8-9, 2019, the Bylaws of the USCSA have been updated to reflect the adopted change in corporate governance structure. For details of these changes, please see Section 10 of the Competition and Rules Manual.
